ARE YOU WONDERING does Sunday evening Mass on Christmas Eve fulfill both the obligation for a Sunday Mass AND

the obligation for a Christmas Day Mass?

Because Catholics participate in Mass on Sundays & Holy Days of Obligation, the answer is "no." The U.S. Bishop's Committee on Divine Worship has said the faithful should participate in 2 Masses, 1 for the 4th Sunday of Advent & 1 for Christmas.

The Sunday obligation can be fulfilled beginning at 4pm (or later) with a Vigil Mass on Sat., Dec. 23rd or on Sun., Dec. 24th before 4pm.

The Christmas Mass obligation can be fulfilled beginning on Sun., Dec. 24th with a Vigil Mass at 4pm (or later) or any time on Monday Dec. 25th.
