The tradition behind the story of Palm Sunday: When the people heard that Christ was coming, *“they took out palm branches and went out to meet him, and cried out, Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, the king of Israel”* (John 12:13) It was a tradition to spread palms before a king as he processed into his city, it was a way to welcome him, to show him glory and homage. This fulfilled the prophecy in the Old testament which declared, *“Behold: your king is coming to you, a just savior is he, humble and riding on a donkey.”* (Zech 9:9)
