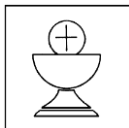
Baptisms - Contact Pastor to schedule baptisms and preparatory classes.


